Weeknight League Sub List

If your schedule makes it difficult to join a league, but you'd like to play from time to time, sign up as a sub for as many leagues as you want. League members or captains will email you when a sub is needed and you'll pay the league sub fee each time you play.

Sign up online. To become a Weeknight League sub, visit the Chapter Web site. From the **ACTIVITIES tab** on the home page, select Leagues and click through the link to sign up.

Weekend Travel League

A bit more informal than our weeknight leagues, the travel league (WTL) plays at various courses on Saturdays and/or Sundays throughout the golf season. Our captains reserve 3-4 tee times and email details each week to everyone on the WTL list. You simply respond by the stated deadline to "reserve" a spot in the field, and pay your greens fee at the pro shop when you sign in to play.

Sign up online. To add your name to the Weekend Travel League roster, visit the Chapter Web site. From the **ACTIVITIES tab** on the home page, select Leagues and click through the link to sign up.

League Level Indicators

Because golfers have more fun and a better chance to succeed on courses geared to their ability, our schedule of nine-hole Weeknight Leagues offers a range of courses suited to all skill levels. To help you decide which ones are best for you, we've assigned one of three level indicators to each league. The indicator is based the course rating and slope* and the competitive format (if any) of each league.

- **New.** Most appropriate for beginning golfers, those who have not played much and want to improve their skills and understanding of golf rules and etiquette. If you never or seldom keep score or generally shoot 60 or higher for nine holes, look for leagues indicated as "New." [\[Both new golfer leagues begin the week after a four-week "Get Ready Golf" clinic, the same evening at the same course. Get details and register separately for the clinic online. Go to Education from the ACTIVITIES tab.\]](#)
- **Occasional.** Appropriate for golfers with consistent basic skills and a command of rules, etiquette and pace of play. If you consistently shoot in the 50s or better for nine holes, look for leagues indicated as "Occasional."
- **Advanced.** Intended for more experienced players, especially those who enjoy the challenge of more difficult course. If you consistently shoot under 50 for nine holes, look for leagues indicated as "Advanced."
- **Advanced/Competitive.** Intended for more experienced players, especially those who enjoy the challenge of more difficult courses and a competitive format. Handicap is required. League will be played in a competitive format (match, stroke, etc), to be determined by league members. If you consistently shoot under 50 for nine holes and want a competitive (but friendly!) format, look for leagues indicated as "Advanced/Competitive."

Of course, we understand that day and location are important factors in league selection, so you are always welcome to join any league that is offered, regardless of your skill level.

* A golf course's course rating and slope are determined by the United States Golf Association. Together, they are used to determine the course's relative difficulty. The course rating is the 18-hole score a scratch golfer would be expected to shoot. The slope calculation is a bit more complicated, but in layman's language, it's a ratio that represents the degree of difficulty based on a bogey golfer's ability. The higher the slope, the harder the course.

Policies & Info

Carts: Except where indicated, all league fees are for walking nine holes. You can always opt to rent a cart at your own expense.

Cancellation Policy: Because the Chapter must pay 100 percent of league fees to the golf courses at the start of the season, we are unable to refund league payments. If you must miss a league night, use the sub system to be reimbursed for that night. The Chapter will do its best to help address unusual circumstances, such as significant injury or relocation, but we cannot guarantee repayment.

Membership and Payment Requirements: In order to join a Chapter Weeknight League, you must be an EWGA member in good standing, with your annual EWGA membership dues paid in full. Your league fee(s), which are additional, must be paid in full before you are confirmed or can participate in the league(s) of your choice. League registration is opened first to members registered for the Chapter's Tee Off Brunch. Registration will close ten days prior to the published league start date.

Attn: Prospective Members. If the Weeknight League you're interested in is full (or the deadline has passed) by the time your EWGA membership is processed, you can still participate! Just sign up (online) as a sub. In fact, we often recommend that new members use the sub system in their first year to try out different leagues and courses and find the one that's the best fit for you in coming years.
